METHODS is a 3-year project that started on the 15th October, 2015 and is co-funded by the Erasmus+ programmed of the European Union. It is coordinated by The University of Jordan (UJ) with 14 partners from Jordan, Palestine and European countries.

The project aims at improving the quality of teaching and learning at the partner universities with cooperation of EU-experience through incorporating technological tools in consistence with pedagogical best practices and by building the capacity of the universities to evaluate, develop and design e-curricula.

METHODS helps students to engage with the material, participate in the class, and collaborate with each other. The students are no longer listen and memorize only; instead, they are demonstrate a process, analyze an argument, or apply a concept to a real-world situation.

Monitoring visit

November 13, 2017 The University of Jordan Amman-Jordan



The National Erasmus+ office (NEO) in Jordan conducted a monitoring visit on November 13, 2017, for the Erasmus+ project "METHODS: Modernization of Teaching Methodologies in Higher Education: Eu Experience For Jordan And Palestinian Territory" at the School of Engineering-The University of Jordan (UJ).

The event was attended by METHODS' team members at the University of Jordan, including faculty members from different faculties, and the administrative and technical staff. In addition to representatives from the project partners in Jordan including Jordan University of Science and Technology, Hashemite University, and Al- Zaytoonah University.

The event also gathered the local coordinator of METHODS in Palestine and the leader for Implementation work package; Dr. Wasel Ghanem from Birzeit University; the leader for Quality work package, Mr. Karl Royle from University of Wolverhampton in United Kingdom, and the project external evaluator, Dr. Jill Turbin from UK.





The Monitoring visit was started by a presentation about status and progress of METHODS project and management procedures, delivered by the General project coordinator, <u>Prof. Ahmed Al-Salaymeh</u>, followed by presentations about the courses development process, and the quality assurance procedures delivered by <u>Dr. Wasel Ghanem and Mr. Karl Royle</u>, respectively.

The team of NEO has also conducted interviews with faculty members from the university of Jordan and partner universities; and also with the students who are engaged in METHODS courses during the piloting phase this fall semester.

The event was ended by a visit to the office of the University of Jordan President, Prof. Azmi Mahfzah, to indicate the positive feedback that was gained from the visit, and commend the efforts that were made in implementing the project.

A booth for METHODS project with Roll up and brochures was in the exhibition hall of the GCREEDER 2018














What's Coming Up Next

Guidelines Booklet

July, 2018

The focus of this booklet is to provide guidelines to educators how to implement problem and ICT based learning elements into teaching at higher education in Jordan and Palestine. It will be produced as part of The METHODS project overall focus, more specifically work package 3 with focus on capacity building and educational design. The guidelines are based on studies containing observations of developed courses and interviews conducted with students and faculty members at universities in Jordan and Palestine (September 2016 – December 2017).





The results of this studies and resulting recommendations are presented in the manuals background chapter. The remaining chapters contain guidelines to implementing Problem and Competence based Learning (PBL and CBL), Flipped Classrooms and Massively Open Online Courses (MOOCs) in courses in higher education.

In the final conclusion it will present recommendations for future studies and big scale implementation of Problem based ICT education in higher education in a Middle Eastern context. The report will contain figures, pictures from the activities, the participants had been involved in and tables, with consent from all the partners.

Local Training Workshop for Students

May, 2018 The University of Jordan

In the framework of METHODS project a three-day training workshop for students will be held at The University of Jordan during May 21-23, 2018. The training will focus on design thinking from both a theoretic and applied approach to help the students learn how to come up with innovative solutions to identified problems within a number of fields in engineering.
